

- T F 1. The game begins when the first pitch is thrown.
- T F 2. Unused offensive conferences may be carried over to extra innings.
- T F 3. The ball becomes dead immediately when a batter/runner stops and then retreats towards home plate to avoid being tagged.
- T F 4. When the ball slips from the hand of the pitcher on the back swing, the ball is live, any runners may advance at their own risk. It is not considered to be a ball or strike on the batter.
- T F 5. When the pitcher is in position to pitch, the catcher must have at least one foot inside of the catcher's box.
- T F 6. B3 swings at the pitch and misses. The pitched ball strikes B3 on the wrist. The umpire correctly rules dead ball and awards B3 first base for being hit by the pitch.
- T F 7. The on deck batter must take a position within the lines of the on deck circle closest to her dugout.
- T F 8. Any member of the coaching staff and a captain may attend the pre game conference.
- T F 9. A runner sliding beyond the base and making contact with a defensive player is legal as long as the player's act is not intentional.
- T F 10. The flex player may bat in the position occupied by the DP any number of times during the game.
- T F 11. It is legal for the flex player to be listed in the tenth position on the line up card and not participate in the game on offense until the 7th inning.
- T F 12. A flex player listed on the line up card is not required to participate.
- T F 13. The pitcher must be removed on the third offensive visit prior to any extra inning game.
- T F 14. With runners on 1st and 2nd base F6 fields a sharply hit ground ball. With the ball in her non glove hand F6 dives and touches 2nd base with the gloved hand prior to runner R1 arriving at 2nd base. The umpire correctly rules the runner R1 to be safe.
- T F 15. The batter runner is out in all situations when the 3rd strike on a batter is recorded and 1st base is occupied.
